My Own Animal Sounds

Help your baby learn early listening skills, understanding the difference between sound and silence.

Encourage your baby to discriminate between music and voice using the recorded music and animal sounds.

Listen and move with your baby to the rhythmic and repetitive music which sounds like a horse.



Toddlers

This musical track highlights the difference between sound and silence. In the next track use one animal sound.

4 pre-recorded animal sounds (cat, dog, duck, monkey) help your toddler to begin to discriminate and identify sounds.

Help your toddler to discriminate between 3 and 4 animal sounds using your own toys.

Use this track with the cat, dog, duck and monkey picture cards.

Use this track to add your own different animals with pictures or toys to develop listening and speech.
